Tax Relief on Contributions

The Parish as an eligible charity can claim tax relief on your donation, provided it is more than €250 annually. This means the Parish can benefit some more from your generosity as a tax payer without it costing you anything additional.

By way of example, a donation of €5 per week is €260 for the year. With the tax rebate this will be worth €376.81 to the parish. Likewise, a total annual donation of €750 will be worth €1087, and a donation of €1000 will be worth €1449.

If you are eligible for the scheme which applies both to Self-Assessed and PAYE taxpayers and have not completed the CHY form in the last 5 years, the Parish will forward one to you on request – you do not have to contact the Revenue Commissioners yourself.

GDPR

The personal information you provide is used by the parish to process the contribution in line with revenue guidelines. It is not shared with any other person or organisation. The information is kept only for as long as necessary and is then deleted from our systems.
