What is World Mission Sunday?

World Mission Sunday is the Holy Father's annual appeal to support overseas mission and missionaries. It takes place in every single parish worldwide where the church is present. In Ireland, Missio Ireland is tasked with organizing the Mission Sunday collection. Missio Ireland is the Pope's official charity for overseas mission.

October and World Mission Sunday is a time for the faithful of the world to show their appreciation towards the work of overseas missionaries. The generosity offered will be used to support missionary activities in over 1,100 struggling dioceses; mostly in Africa, Asia and Latin America.

The mission Sunday collection will replace the share (2nd) collection at all masses on Sunday 22nd October.

You can also donate €4 by texting the word 'Mission' to 50300.
